JAMB ADVISES PARENTS TO STOP BASELESS ALLEGATIONS AGAINST UNIVERSITIES



The Joint Admissions and Matriculation Board (JAMB) is again compelled to refute the series of baseless allegations by some

candidates and their parents, alleging denial of admission despite what, to them, were high scores of the candidates in the Unified Tertiary Matriculation Examination (UTME). A recent case involved a parent, who publicly accused the University of Calabar of unjustly denying his child what he deemed a "rightful admission."

One of the most recent cases was that of Mr. Godwin Nsan, who publicly accused the University of Calabar of unjust handling

UPLOADING OF BLANK REGISTRATION TEMPLATE: JAMB SUSPENDS TWO CENTRES FOR 14 DAYS

The Joint Admissions and Matriculation Board (JAMB) has suspended the Federal College of Education (Technical) Potiskum CBT Centre 2 in Yobe State and the CBT Centre, Otukpo, Benue State, for a period of 14 days, effective today, Tuesday, February 4, 2025.

This suspension follows a significant procedural breach that jeopardizes the security measures implemented to prevent infractions and to ensure the integrity of the information provided to the Board in case of any contestation.

2025 UTME TIMELINE

UTME application starts Monday, 3rd February, 2025 and ends Saturday, 8th March, 2025.

Direct Entry (D/E) application starts Monday, 10th March, 2025 and ends Monday, 7th April, 2025.

Mock Exam date is Saturday, 5th April, 2025.

UTME will commence on Friday, 25th April, 2025 and end on Monday, 5th May, 2025.

FIRST WEEK PAYMENT TO CBT CENTRES

In line with its commitment to weekly payments of UTME registration charges collected as part of the total fee for UTME to CBT centres, the Board has made the first-week payment in fulfillment of its promise regarding the disbursement of these charges. This payment, which aligns with the Board's cashless registration policy, amounts to **N141,306,900** for the week. This sum corresponds to the registration fees collected for the **201,867** candidates registered during the first week.

of his son's admission. He had protested in writing to JAMB but was unwilling to provide requested details to establish his case despite pleas from the Board. When he eventually provided the details after he had unduly castigated the University in the media, it was discovered that the score (ranking) of the child who scored 201 in the UTME and whose aggregate score was 34% fell below the 55%; 35% and 35 which were for Merit; Catchment and ELDS respectively whereas he had unduly castigated the University.

To help mitigate such misunderstandings, JAMB has implemented a robust communication system – the Ticketing Platform – where candidates and their guardians can seek clarification before airing grievances publicly. As a regulatory body, JAMB is committed to ensuring that qualified candidates are not substituted for inferior candidates, which is why we established the Central Admissions Processing System (CAPS) to transparently rank candidates for admission selection.

Similarly, a senior public figure alleged that Modibbo Adama University, Yola, sidelined some candidates in its admission exercise. JAMB promptly investigated and found the claims to be unfounded. We communicated our findings to the individual, clarifying why his assertions of discrimination were inaccurate.

To promote accountability among institutions and ensure adherence to admission guidelines, JAMB shared its findings with the relevant universities. The Board will continue to share such with institutions, where

necessary, even as the Board, however, cautions institutions against disclosing such confidential information meant solely for institutional use to the public or media. While the Board welcomes genuine complaints, it detests public condemnation of tertiary institutions, who are merely doing their duties.

Recently, a parent publicly claimed that his son, who scored 345, was unjustly denied admission to the University of Jos without valid reasons. JAMB participated in a radio programme to clarify the admission ranking process, advising candidates to consider the overall results rather than relying solely on personal perceptions of brilliance. The candidate and his father were invited to the National Headquarters, where they were shown the result with the son being ranked 86th among other candidates, while only 68 could be admitted based on merit. It is essential to note that in some universities, a score of 345 might rank a candidate as low as 300, depending on the university's subscription capacity.

The father was subsequently invited to view the admission platform and the ranking of his son. It was there that he saw the strenuous job bring done by the Board to engender equity and fairness and he apologised and left apparently satisfied.

In light of these circumstances, JAMB advises parents to refrain from being swayed by their subjective perceptions of their children's exceptional abilities without considering the broader context of overall candidate performance. This perspective can help mitigate

feelings of desperation and disappointment.

A further example of this misplaced belief in exceptionalism is the misuse of the "exceptionally brilliant window" introduced for the 2025 UTME. This provision allows candidates younger than 16 to sit the examination if they can demonstrate outstanding performance through meeting the standard set by the Board. Surprisingly, a ridiculously high number of candidates have registered through this window, a phenomenon virtually unheard of globally, where only a small fraction typically qualifies. Parents are advised not to exaggerate the brilliance of their children without realising that there are more brilliant candidates out there.

JAMB remains committed to protecting the rights of all candidates by ensuring fair and equitable selection through transparent ranking based on performance. We will investigate any allegations of unfair treatment and provide necessary clarifications.

Currently, a senior university staff is being prosecuted for admission-related crimes, with four others under investigation. JAMB does not tolerate any admission infractions and will take appropriate action against any individuals involved in questionable practices regarding admissions.

We urge parents to refrain from jumping to conclusions without considering the performance of other candidates. The UTME serves as a ranking examination by determining a candidate's position within a cohort for the limited available spaces in our nation's tertiary institutions.

uploaded as evidence of their choices and the information provided. It is concerning that some centres, despite being fully briefed on the implications of failing to adhere to these guidelines, have chosen to disregard them by submitting blank copies of the registration template in a misguided effort to increase

candidate submissions.

This suspension serves as a stern warning to any centres considering similar actions. Any centre found uploading blank templates in the future will face cancellation and will be barred from participating in the Board's activities.

The 2025 UTME registration began on

Monday, February 3, 2025, and will conclude on March 8, 2025. CBT centres are strongly advised to ensure that all templates are filled out clearly and accurately before uploading.

PREMIUM TIMES, SUNDAY, FEBRUARY 2, 2025: UNILAG Develops Policy on Ethical Use of AI in Academia: – The University of Lagos (UNILAG) has announced plans to unveil a policy document on the ethical use of Artificial Intelligence (AI) in academic activities.

The University's Deputy Vice-Chancellor, Academics and Research, Mrs. Bola Oboh, made this known during the opening of a three-day workshop on ethics in higher education held at the university.

According to Prof. Oboh, the policy aims at “enhancing critical thinking rather than fostering plagiarism and academic indolence.”

The workshop was facilitated by a Fulbright Specialist Awardee and Deputy Ethics Officer at Texas A&M University, Central Texas, USA, Russell Porter.

NATION, SUNDAY, FEBRUARY 2, 2025: House Speaker Calls for Standardised Examinations, Modern Curriculum in Universities: – The Speaker of the House of Representatives, Rt. Hon. Tajudeen Abbas, has called for the introduction of standardized examinations across Nigerian universities and a complete overhaul of outdated curricula to align with global realities and industry demands.

Speaking at the convocation lecture of the Federal University of Technology, Minna, Hon. Abbas said... “The time has come for all universities to have common examinations, at least at the graduating level; let there be one common examination for the various courses being offered. That is how we can determine whether the grades awarded by some universities are truly reflective of students' capabilities and whether they can stand the test of time,” he stated.

PUNCH, MONDAY, FEBRUARY 3, 2025: UNILORIN Promotes 20 New Professors, 31 Readers: – The Governing Council of the University of Ilorin has approved the promotion of 51 academic staff to the positions of Professors and Readers in various faculties of the institution.

In a statement by the University Registrar, Mr. Adeleke Alfanla, 20 Readers were promoted to the professorial level while 31 Senior Lecturers were upgraded to the position of Readers...

The statement said, “The Appointments and Promotions Committee (A&PC), at its 186th meeting held on Monday, 27th January 2025, considered the recommendations from the 2024 promotion exercise for the promotion of some eligible members of the academic staff of the University to the positions of Professor and Reader.”

PUNCH, MONDAY, FEBRUARY 3, 2025: NELFUND Pays N20bn School Fees for 192, 906 Students: – The Nigerian Education Loan Fund has announced that it has disbursed over N20 billion in institutional fees to tertiary institutions nationwide, benefiting 192,906 students.

In a statement released by its management in Abuja, NELFUND addressed widespread misconceptions about the total amount disbursed, clarifying that reports of N104 billion were inaccurate.

“As of February 3, 2025, NELFUND has received a total of 364,042 student loan applications. So far, the Fund has disbursed a total of N20, 074,050,000 for institutional fees, benefiting 192,906 students across various tertiary institutions,” the

statement read.

Beyond tuition fees, the Fund has also provided financial support for students' upkeep, disbursing over N12 billion in stipends. Reaffirming its commitment to transparency and efficiency...”

VANGUARD, MONDAY, FEBRUARY 3, 2025: Why JAMB Suspended Redeemer's Varsity Law Admissions-Management: – The management of Redeemer's University, Ede, Osun, has explained why its law programme was suspended for one year by the Joint Admissions and Matriculation Board (JAMB).

The management's explanation is contained in a statement by the Deputy Director, Corporate Affairs of the University, Adetunji Adeleye, recently in Osogbo.

The statement said the law programme was suspended by Council for Legal Education (CLE), to penalise the University for commencing the programme in 2017, with only the approval of National Universities Commission (NUC)...

2025: Reps Move to Transform Michael Okpara University into Conventional University: – The House of Representatives has passed a bill through its second reading seeking to transform Michael Okpara University of Agriculture, Umudike, into a conventional university.

The proposed legislation, titled "Bill Seeking for an Act to Establish Michael Okpara University, Umudike, to Make Comprehensive Provisions for Its Due Management and Administration and for Related Matters," was sponsored by Deputy Speaker Rt. Hon. Benjamin Kalu and six other lawmakers.

Leading the debate, co-sponsor Hon. Kelechi Nwogu recalled that the university was originally established in November 1992 as a specialized institution focused on agriculture and related sciences, in line with the Federal Universities of Agriculture Act, Cap F22, Laws of the Federation of Nigeria, 2004...

Hon. Nwogu emphasized that, "The transition to a conventional university would allow MOUAU to offer a broad range of academic programs in fields like Arts, Medicine, Law, Social Sciences, and Humanities," he stated. "This diversification would attract a larger, more varied student population, making MOUAU a hub for learners from diverse backgrounds."

PUNCH, FRIDAY, FEBRUARY 7, 2025: Education Ministry Dismisses Reports on Scrapping JSS, SSS: – The Ministry of Education has clarified that the Minister of Education, Dr. Tunji Alausa, merely proposed the introduction of a 12-year basic education system.

The ministry stated that reports of an immediate policy change on the matter were untrue.

Several media outlets had suggested that a new policy aimed at scrapping the Junior and Senior Secondary School system was already in effect.

At Yakubu Gowon University, President Tinubu dissolved the entire governing council and relieved Professor Aisha Sani Maikudi of her duties as the Vice-Chancellor.

OPINION- PROFESSOR IS-HAQ OLOYEDE: A CHAMPION IN THE FIGHT AGAINST EXAMINATION MALPRACTICE IN NIGERIA

The Federal Government of Nigeria has launched a committee to eradicate examination malpractices, with Professor Ishaq Oloyede at the helm. As Registrar of the Joint Admissions and Matriculation Board (JAMB), Oloyede has been a vocal advocate for eliminating examination malpractices that have plagued Nigeria's education system for decades.

Examination malpractices in Nigeria date back to 1914, during the Cambridge examination. Various stakeholders, including parents, teachers, and candidates, have contributed to the menace. Oloyede identifies the proliferation of illegal tutorial centers, or "miracle centers," as a major contributor to examination malpractices. These centers, often owned by influential individuals, compromise the examination process.

Despite challenges, Oloyede remains committed to eradicating examination malpractices. As Registrar of JAMB, he introduced

measures to prevent exam malpractices, including biometric data. He emphasizes the need for collective action, describing exam malpractices as a "national embarrassment."

Oloyede's appointment as Chairman of the National Committee to Eradicate Examination Malpractice reflects his dedication. The committee comprises key stakeholders from various examination bodies, aiming to tackle examination malpractice.

The committee inaugurated in the Conference Hall of Ministry of Education in Abuja recently comprises key stakeholders from various examination bodies, including JAMB, WAEC, NECO, NABTEB, ANCOSS, and the Nigeria Union of Teachers. Their primary objective is to tackle examination malpractice, a longstanding issue in Nigeria's education system.

Minister of Education Dr. Maruf Olatunji Alausa praised Oloyede's reformist leadership and innovative use of technology. Dr. Alausa

emphasized restoring integrity to Nigeria's education system, stating, "This is not a fight against students but a collective effort to secure the future of education in Nigeria."

The committee is expected to submit recommendations by mid-2025. The government has directed examination bodies to adopt enhanced security measures, including integrating photographs, Birth Certificates, and National Identification Numbers (NIN), into certificates by June 2025.

Oloyede's track record in reforming institutions is impressive. As Vice-Chancellor of the University of Ilorin, he laid groundwork for institutional excellence. At JAMB, he revolutionized the admissions process, bringing transparency and technological advancement.

With his leadership, Nigeria can look forward to a credible education system where examination integrity is upheld, and hard work and merit are rewarded.

MANDATORY USE OF THE NATIONAL IDENTIFICATION NUMBER (NIN) FOR REGISTRATION WITH JAMB BY CANDIDATES APPLYING FOR NON-REGULAR PROGRAMMES

This Advisory is issued to all the concerned institutions, and candidates desirous of applying to study under the non-regular mode of study in tertiary institutions in Nigeria.

As part of measures to checkmate the nefarious activities of fraudulent characters, who are scheming to compromise candidates' records through dubious registration channels and in compliance with its enabling act, JAMB has mandated that all applicants desirous of studying in Nigerian tertiary institutions must provide their NIN while registering for any programme of study in any tertiary institution in Nigeria irrespective of whether the mode of study is **regular and non-regular**.

2. Consequently, it has now become mandatory for all prospective candidates in the **non-regular category (NOUN, Distance Learning, Part-time and Sandwich programmes)** to create a profile code, before registering with JAMB, by sending their NIN, through their unique phone number to either of the Board's sort code (55019 or 66019).
3. Immediately after the creation of profile, each candidate will proceed to a CBT Centre for registration. After the registration, the candidate's details will appear on the CAPS of the institution of choice under non-regular admission. The institution will then propose and recommend to the Board for approval and the candidate will accept and print admission letter.
4. Furthermore, all previous candidates in the non-regular programmes, who had not integrated their NIN or unique phone number on the Board's platform, would have to create a profile using their respective NINs to access any of the services of the Board.
5. No candidate can use the process to change any of the data already supplied to the Board.
6. JAMB, as a responsive organisation that is conscious of the peculiarities of the non-regular studies, will continue to make the registration process as flexible as possible by making its platform available throughout the year. It is, therefore, expected that candidates, who fall under this category, will apply through JAMB before approaching their preferred institutions to process their admission with their respective JAMB registration numbers. They would also be expected to pay their preferred institution a processing fee as determined by the respective institutions.
7. Please be guided for compliance.

...JAMB to Enforce 16 Year Entry Age Limit

examinations stated in our advertisement.

The Registrar, Prof. Is-haq Oloyede, disclosed this at a meeting with critical stakeholders comprising Chief External Examiners (CEEs), Chief Technical Advisors (CTAs) and Equal Opportunity Group (EOG). Other stakeholders included Virtues Vanguard, Peace Monitors, High-Power Opinion Leaders, Civil Society and Mass Media, General Monitors, Roving Group and the Bwari Call Centre.

The meeting with the stakeholders is to prepare for the 2025 UTME registration exercise, review past performances and discuss issues regarding the upcoming 2025 UTME. The Registrar pointed out that the national minimum admissible age is 16, as such, any candidates below 16 years by September, 2025, would not be considered for admission.

"This is about complying with the law, age has a lot to do with maturity in terms of what you do. Age can't be discarded. Otherwise, you wouldn't be prescribing that before you can

become a Local Government Chairman, you must have attained a certain age or even a child of 5 or 10 years could aspire to that office.

"Biological age has a lot to do with the development of the intelligence. There are so many things that have been said, but there are exceptions to the rule, and you must allow for such exceptions.

"The Honourable Minister of Education mentioned it clearly when he assumed office that the minimum age for admission would be sixteen, but we are also aware that there are gifted children and they are few. These gifted children can't be dismissed like that. We will have to identify them and allow them to take the exam.

"Now, the question is about identifying them. There are so many criteria we'll look at if you're under sixteen and you're exceptional. First, your records should show that you're exceptional. If you take UTME, for instance, and you score 200 out of 400, how do you call yourself an exceptional candidate, but if you

score 80%, that is giving us a signal that, 'Oh, this person is really exceptional.'

He said that any exceptional candidate must be exceptional not through mere words but in all ramifications such that either in the UTME, WAEC, Post-UTME, or the GCE O/level, he must score at least 80 percent.

The Registrar also lamented that private universities encourage underage admission and, in most cases, 80 percent of their intakes end up being migrated to other programmes owing to poor standing.

He further noted that the Board is not unaware of these sharp practices that parents perpetrate to alter the age of their wards for the purpose of admission and on graduation, they apply for a reduction of that same age to enable their wards undergo the one-year mandatory service of the National Youth Service Corps (NYSC).

FORMER DG, NDLEA, VETERAN JOURNALIST, STAKEHOLDERS COMMEND OLOYEDE

The Joint Admissions and Matriculation Board has vowed to provide equal opportunity to all candidates desirous of taking the 2025 Unified Tertiary Matriculation Examination (UTME).

According to the Board, no candidate would be discriminated against on account of deformities or any forms of challenges. It also restated its commitment to providing equal opportunity for candidates with disabilities, candidates with biometrics

challenges and those serving jail terms, among others, desirous of tertiary education.

To ensure that all candidates are provided with a level playing field to compete favourably with their peers, the JAMB Equal Opportunity Group (JEOG) has been further strengthened to achieve its mandate.

Furthermore, the Board disclosed that as part of its commitment and determination to ensure inclusivity, blind candidates, are to indicate their disability by typing BLIND as

well as pick the option of either sitting the examination through Braille, Recorded, or Read Aloud mode.

In the same vein, candidates with Albinism, Down Syndrome, Autism, Dyslexia, and Attention Deficit Hyperactivity Disorder (ADHD) Amputees, Lame, Paralysed, Cerebral Palsy are to indicate their disabilities by clicking on the appropriate box so as to be identified and assigned to the JAMB Equal Opportunity Group (JEOG) for special attention.

CANDIDATES WITH BIOMETRIC CHALLENGES CAN ONLY REGISTER IN JAMB HQ

...JAMB Warns CBT Centres Against Extortion, Restates Commitment to Cashless Registration

to cashless registration saying stiffer sanctions await centres that flout this policy, which was introduced to curb unwholesome practices. Consequently, to effectively track down infractors, the Board has

activated varied surveillance mechanisms to protect innocent candidates.

The Board said with the adoption of the cashless system, it would be collecting the approved registration

fee on behalf of the various centres along with its UTME registration fees and pay them their money on a weekly basis.

JAMB UPHOLDS FREE UTME APPLICATION FOR CANDIDATES WITH DISABILITIES

The Joint Admissions and Matriculation Board (JAMB) has said it will continue to uphold decisions reached at the 1st National Conference on Equal Opportunity of Access to Higher Education for Candidates with Disabilities, especially with regard to that, which obligates the Board to issue free UTME forms to candidates with disabilities who possess five O'level credits.

While assessing the impact of the scheme, the Board noted that the free UTME application forms regime

started last year, and has, not only cushioned the financial burden on this category of candidates, but has also greatly improved their access to tertiary education.

To operationalise the scheme, the Board had charged the JAMB-Equal Opportunity Group (JEOG), in conjunction with the National Commission for Persons with Disabilities (NCPWD), to work out the necessary modalities for its smooth implementation.

To forestall the incidence of impersonators, the Board has

directed that candidates with disabilities would buy their application documents as other candidates and on the day of examination, after their verification and authentication, such candidate would be refunded their application fees.

The Board assured candidates with disabilities that it would continue to do everything possible within allowable limits to advance their cause.

BE COURTEOUS, B. USMAN ADMONISHES UTME REGISTRATION OFFICIALS



The Acting Director, Information Technology Services Department, Joint Admissions and Matriculation Board (JAMB), Mrs. Funmilola B. Usman, has admonished 2025 UTME registration officials to be courteous in their dealings with prospective candidates.

The Director, who was speaking recently at a virtual roundtable organised for security operatives and JAMB SERVICOM Desk Officers, stated that aside being courteous, the officials must also possess problem-solving skills, effective communication and technical skills to resolve issues during the registration exercise.

While speaking on the newly-introduced innovations in the 2025 registration, Mrs Usman stressed that certain Templates had been

introduced by the Board towards addressing the various difficulties previously encountered by candidates so as to improve on service delivery.

According to her, TEMPL 001 would be used for UTME registration, TEMPL 002 for Direct Entry, TEMPL 003 for REQUERY, that is, if any candidate who had previously registered, returned to the NIMC platform to effect any change(s) on his/her data, the candidate must fill the template before completing his/her registration as failure to do so would make such correction invalid.

In her words,

"Candidates that have made changes on their details with the NIMC, should send REQUERY followed by a space, then, the 11 digits of the NIN to either 55019 or 66019 through the phone number they had previously used to register. Such candidates are to fill and submit the NIMC Data Override Template (TEMPL 003) before being attended to."

She also stated that for lost Profile Email: Substituting Lost SIM Template (TEMPL 006) must be filled by those whose unique identifier (previously used SIM number) has been lost and could not be retrieved, while TEMPL 007- UTME/DE: Exceptionally Brilliant Candidates Template must be filled by exceptional applicants below the age of sixteen, who must not score less than 80% aggregate in a prescribed intelligence test, UTME, Post-UTME and the SSCE.

2025 UTME: QAD TRAINS STAFF ON ACCURATE REPORTING, DEPARTMENTAL DELIVERABLES



Ahead of the 2025 Unified Tertiary Matriculation Examination, the Quality Assurance Department, JAMB, has trained its staff on the importance of establishing an accurate reporting system.

The Department also sensitised its staff on how to keep track of the departmental deliverables to ensure that the Department met its expected standards and strategic goals.

The Director, Quality Assurance Department (QAD), Mrs. Doom Iyortyom, urged the staff to brace up for the coming examination and strive for excellence at all times.

She stressed the need for prompt attendance at work, synergy, communication, teamwork and effective collaboration stating that "you get better results working as a team."

She pointed out that the training was necessary to get the staff acquainted with happenings in the Board with a view to enhancing efficiency of labour and productivity. In a presentation by the Head of Investigation and Standard (I&S), Mr. Buhari Aliyu, titled: "Importance of

Accurate Reporting System," he tasked staff on the essence of generating accurate and reliable reports noting that anything short of this will not augur well for the Board's efforts to collect and collate information garnered from the field. He also disclosed that accurate and adequate information would also assist the Board greatly in the event of litigation.

Buhari equally enlightened the participants on how to fill and arrange reports forms such as the Supervisor, Technical Staff, Biometric Verification Reporting Officer, CPN, Proctors, Centre Administrator and Centre Technical Staff Report forms. Similarly, the Head of Monitoring and Evaluation Division, Dr. Grace Onoja, took the staff through her paper titled: "Departmental Deliverables Monitoring."

According to her, the objective of her presentation is to make staff know and understand clearly what the monitoring function of the Department entails.

Dr Onoja's presentation also shed more light on departmental deliverables as products or services

to be provided, while Departmental Performance Measurement Template (DPMT), serves as a tool for monitoring Key Performance Indicators(KPI). She opined that all these mechanisms for measurement are formulated with a view to improving staff monitoring skills, as well as enhance their analytical and reporting skills.

She further explained that the departmental deliverables monitoring is a proactive measure that enables the identification of potential risks and deviations so as to mitigate any negative impacts on the Board.

Additionally, Dr Onoja also noted that departmental deliverables would help to foster collaboration and engagement with staff of other Departments by keeping track of their deliverables thus providing regular updates and feedbacks to the Department.

Dr Onoja, therefore, enjoined QA staff to see themselves as quality controller as they should always ensure that the various departmental deliverables meet the quality benchmarks of the Board.

EDO EDUCATION COMMISSIONER HOLDS STAKEHOLDERS' INTERACTION WITH JAMB, OTHERS

The Honourable Commissioner of Education, Edo State, Dr. Paddy Iyamu, on Tuesday, 4th February, 2025, held a stakeholders' interaction with the Joint Admissions and Matriculation Board (JAMB) and other educational players in Edo State.

Declaring the meeting open, the Hon Commissioner disclosed that he had summoned the meeting to discuss practical measures towards addressing the various challenges confronting the education sector in the State.

For a start, Dr. Iyamu, in his explanation, canvassed for a unified curriculum for secondary schools, stressing that this would address knowledge gaps among secondary

school students.

The Commissioner also noted that the uncensored activities of owners of tutorial classes in the State were becoming worrisome as they interfere with the school calendar and curriculum.

Speaking further, he frowned at the exorbitant fees being charged by private secondary schools in the State, noting that these place too much burden on the citizenry while charging all educational stakeholders including teachers, school proprietors, parents and the media, to prioritise transmission of values and norms worthy of emulation and legacy to the coming generation, saying, "They are the hopes of the country as education is

one of the critical tools needed for building a safe and better society."

Other notable personalities at the event included the State Permanent Secretary, Ministry of Education, Mrs. Edith Ebomwonyi; Directors of MDAs in the Education sector; Chairman, National Association of Proprietors of Private Schools (NAPSS); Chairman, Association of Private Schools Owners in Nigeria (APSON); Chairman, Association for Formidable Educational Development (AFED); President, Catholic Education Commission (CEC); Association of Modern Islamic Schools (AMIS); and notable Publishers in the State.

2025 UTME/DE REGISTRATION: GOMBE STATE COORDINATOR VISITS SPECIAL EDUCATION CENTRE



As part of advocacy for the ongoing 2025 UTME/DE registration exercise, the Gombe State Coordinator, Mr. Johnson Adebiyi, on Friday, 31st December, 2025, paid a working visit to the Special Education Centre, Gombe, to sensitize eligible students of the school on the need to actively participate in the ongoing 2025 UTME/DE registration exercise. In his remarks, the Principal of the Special Education Centre, Mr. Muhammed Ahmed Lawal, thanked the State Coordinator for his care and promised that the students would take advantage of the ample opportunities provided by the Board.

JAMB ISSUES WARNING AGAINST NOCTURNAL REGISTRATION PRACTICES

In light of this, JAMB provides clarity and issues a stern warning to the centres listed below, as well as any others that may consider engaging in similar practices, to immediately cease these activities.
