

EXEMPTION OF CERTAIN CATEGORIES OF CANDIDATES FROM SCREENING TEST BY INSTITUTIONS

o attract more foreign candidates into Nigerian tertiary institutions and broaden inclusiveness, all candidates in foreign countries, Correctional Centres, as well as Blind and Deaf Candidates are to be exempted from pre-admission institutions screening tests.

Consequently, for every year preceding the admission exercise, the lists of the respective candidates in these categories would be made available to the various Tertiary Institutions for guidance and necessary action.

This special waiver is to be seen as affirmative and inclusive action for the accommodation of the affected

candidates. The Board and the Tertiary Institutions would ensure that candidates from these categories who meet minimum requirements are admitted and their progress monitored in the various institutions for the purpose of confirmation of the effectiveness of the policy as directed by the 2021 Policy Meeting.

The Joint Admissions and Matriculation Board has put in place mechanisms that would prevent any candidate from taking undue advantage of this exemption. For instance, only candidates who are either foreigners or Nigerians that have been confirmed to be residents in foreign countries and are products of foreign

school systems can enjoy this privilege in the interest of internationalization of the nation's Tertiary Institutions. A Nigerian with less than six (6) month-stay in a foreign country is disallowed from taking the UTME in any foreign country.

This effort is to enhance the intake of international students into our tertiary institutions to improve their global rating.

The Board is at the moment working on some policy directions to make our universities attractive to foreign students.

Dr Anate urged members of staff of the Joint Admissions and Matriculation Board (JAMB) to take advantage of the facilities provided by the hospital to assess quality healthcare services.

He said, "Staff of JAMB and all Bwari residents, in general, should feel free to

access healthcare services in the hospital any time they need to do so. Again, the hospital is one of the few public hospitals in the FCT that uses a reliable electronic medical record system which ensures fast service delivery and safe record keeping." Dr Anate also said the ventilators donated by JAMB in the wake of COVID-19 to mitigate the effects of the pandemic has really been of help to mankind particularly the hospital to consolidate on the gains of the hospital in the management of COVID-19 cases and to ameliorate the difficulty in managing other victims with other challenges that require them to be placed on life support. The youthful medic commended the leadership of JAMB under Prof. Is-haq Oloyede for his ingenuity and intervention in healthcare and the education sector in general adding that the ventilator provided by JAMB has been very helpful to the hospital.

The CMD counselled Bwari residents to take proactive measures to protect themselves against the deadly virus particularly as it relates to the third wave as well as imbibing other non-pharmaceutical safety protocols.

He said, "Among other measures, the strict wearing of face masks by all, regular

use of hand sanitisers and practice of social distancing have been very helpful. The CMD noted further that the immediate identification, isolation and testing of suspected cases followed by referrals to COVID-19 treatment centres will equally reduce its spread."

Commenting on the administration of vaccines and enlightenment in Bwari Area Council, Dr Anate said,

"The FCT Public Health Department, in particular, and other FCT hospitals staff including those of General Hospital, Bwari, are constantly engaging in the sensitisation of Bwari citizens towards appreciating the benefits of COVID-19 vaccines. I believe in its efficacy against COVID-19 and I had since taken my two jabs."

The Consultant Obstetrician & Gynaecologist who has spent almost two decades in the trade of saving life and administration of medical care said his mission was to turn General Hospital, Bwari, into a world-class health facility.

RESULT FALSIFICATION: COURT ADJOURNS CASE TO DECEMBER 8TH

he Chief Magistrate Court sitting in Bwari has adjourned the case between Ejeh James and Michael Yusuf versus the Joint Admissions and Matriculation Board (JAMB) to 8th December, 2021. The case which is in connection with the forgery of the JAMB

examination slip was heard on 25th October 2021, at the Chief Magistrate Court, Bwari, when the two suspects, Ejeh James and Michael Yusuf, were arraigned before Justice Rosemary Kanyib.

The suspects had pleaded not guilty to

the charge.

The judge granted the duo bail at the sum of fifty thousand naira (N50, 000)each and a surety who must be a senior civil servant resident in Bwari.

ADMISSION INTO PART-TIME, SANDWICH AND DISTANCE LEARNING PROGRAMMES

o ensure flexibility in the periods of application for Part-Time, Sandwich and Distance Learning programmes, the Joint Admissions and Matriculation Board shall make available, throughout the year, its online application platform for candidates who desire to enroll in these non-regular programmes given the directive that all admissions must be routed through JAMB.

The public is to note that this policy directive is without prejudice to the processing fees being charged by respective Tertiary Institutions for their not disqualify them. These categories of irregular programmes. candidates would pay to their preferred

The process stipulates that candidates for Distance Learning, Part-time and other related modes of study will apply through JAMB before approaching their preferred institutions to process their admission using JAMB Registration Numbers.

In addition, all categories of candidates for admissions into these programmes must be processed through Central Admission Processing System (CAPS). Distance Learning, Part-time and Sandwich candidates need not sit the UTME but taking the examination does

not disqualify them. These categories of candidates would pay to their preferred institution, a processing fee (not application fee), that will be determined by the institutions.

The Registration Forms being completed at the Institutions should be named "Part-time/Distance Learning Processing Form" to avoid confusion.

The public is also to note that Academic Sessions are from 1st August to 31st July. Therefore, the date of admission determines the session to which a candidate is admitted.

He said, "I expect our universities to conduct researches targeted at discovering an antidote to COVID-19.

PUNCH NEWSPAPER TUESDAY 26TH OCTOBER, 2021 - Only 1 % of JAMB Applicants Choose Polytechnics, Says ASUP: The leadership of the Academic Staff Union of Polytechnic (ASUP) has lamented the neglect of Nigeria's polytechnic which it said has led to low patronage by students seeking admission into higher institutions.

Speaking at a media briefing in Abuja as part of the activities during the advocacy round-table on the future of Nigeria's Polytechnic system, ASUP President, Mr Anderson Ezeibe disclosed that only one per cent of candidates in the Joint Admission and Matriculation's Unified Tertiary Matriculation Examinations apply for polytechnics.

He argued that some of the government's policies and pronouncements had helped to de-market the polytechnic system in the country.

"The low appetite for polytechnics today is evidenced by the one per cent approximate applicant figures for polytechnics in the Unified Tertiary Matriculation Examinations in the last five years as young Nigerians continue to show their preference for the other tiers of tertiary education in the country," he said. The Joint Admissions and Matriculation Board (JAMB) has said it would no longer condone any illegal or irregular admission conducted by any tertiary institution, warning candidates to desist from accepting admissions offered by the institutions without going through the JAMB's Central Admission Processing System (CAPS).

The examination body gave the warning in an advisory issued to the heads of the various tertiary institutions, which was also published in its weekly bulletin.

The advisory states that all applications for admissions to first degree, ND, NCE including full time, part-time, distance learning, outreach, sandwich, among others must be processed ONLY through JAMB.

The advisory, therefore, urges the concerned institutions to encourage their candidates to apply to their programmes through the examination body, noting that duplication of application forms is also not allowed.

"On the other hand, candidates are to ensure that any admission issued to them by any institution is routed through the Board even before considering accepting such offers," said JAMB.
