

BACKGROUND INFORMATION

- ✓ The Board in 2018 initiated the NATAP-M Award to deserving institutions to encourage compliance with the admission guidelines and healthy competition
- ✓ This award has criteria which are all geared towards enhancing the conduct of admission
- ✓ Each of the categories attract N100 Million (75M for 1st, 15M for 2nd and 10M for 3rd)

CRITERIA

The institution with the highest number of candidates that applied to it



CATEGORY 2: The Most National in Admission of Candidates

CRITERIA

- ✓ the Institution must have admitted from every State of the Federation & the FCT
- ✓ must have admitted not less than 1,500 candidates
- ✓ must have the fairest in distribution of admitted candidates among its
 Catchment State/all States in the case of Specialized Military
 Institutions
- ✓ must have admitted not less than 0.25 i.e. 1/400 from the highest number of States if not in all States & the FCT for effective coverage

- e. complied with the approved Science/Art Ratio on Admission
- f. updated its records on IBASS
- g. not known to have committed any admission infraction

NOW – ITS CONSOLIDATING THE AWARD PRIZES

- From this year as announced during the last ceremony, the Board in it's determined efforts to ensure that the award creates the needed impact has increased the value of the prize money from the total N500M to N750 Million.
 - Provision was made in the budget as approved by the NASS
- ✓ We got approval of the FME for Consolidation of the five categories of awards into one single award
- ✓ To curtail serial winning by an institution, any winner-institution of the award can only be given nominal award within 5 years of FULL OVERALL winning of the award
- ✓ The OVERALL winning-prize of N500 million is for the institution that emerges as the overall winner in the merged award (incorporating all the 5 segments)
- ✓ To ensure all-inclusiveness of all tertiary institutions N250 Million of the N750M is for subsidiary winners
