2.0 ELIGIBILITY REQUIREMENTS

Interested bidders should submit the following documents:

- a. Evidence of Certificate of Incorporation issued by the Corporate Affairs Commission (CAC) including Form CAC_{1.1} or CAC₂ and CAC₇. Business Name is also acceptable for Services;
- b. Evidence of Company's Income Tax Clearance Certificate (or Personal Income Tax Clearance Certificates of all the Partners in case of Business Name) for the last three (3) years valid till 31st December, 2024;
- c. Evidence of Pension Clearance Certificate valid till 31st December, 2024 (this requirement is only applicable to bidders whose number of staff is 15 and above);
- d. Evidence of Industrial Training Fund (ITF) Compliance Certificate valid till 31st December, 2024 (this requirement is only applicable to bidders whose number of staff is 5 and above or the Bidder's annual turnover is ¥50m and above;
- e. Evidence of Nigeria Social Insurance Trust Fund (NSITF) Clearance Certificate valid till 31st December, 2024;
- f. Evidence of Registration on the National Database of Federal Contractors, Consultants and Service Providers by submission of Interim Registration Report (IRR) expiring on 31st December, 2024 or valid Certificate issued by BPP.

- g. Sworn Affidavit:
 - disclosing whether or not any officer of the relevant committees of the Joint Admissions and Matriculation Board or the Bureau of Public Procurement is a former or present Director, shareholder or

has any pecuniary interest in the bidder and to confirm that all information presented in its bid are true and correct in all particulars;

- that no Director has been convicted in any Country for any criminal offence relating to fraud or financial impropriety or criminal misrepresentation or falsification of facts relating to any matter;
- that the Company is not in receivership, the subject of any form of insolvency or bankruptcy proceedings or the subject of any form of winding up petition or proceedings;
- that the company does not have existing loan or financial liability with a bank, other financial institution or third party that is classified

as doubtful, non-performance, bad or whose repayment portion has

been outstanding for the last four (4) months;

- h. Company Audited Accounts for the last three (3) years: 2021 2023;
- i. Reference Letter from a reputable commercial bank in Nigeria, indicating willingness to provide credit facility for the execution of the project when needed;
- j. Company's Profile with personally endorsed Curriculum Vitae of Key Staff to be deployed for the project, including copies of their Academic/Professional qualifications such as ANAN, ICAN, NITDA/CPN, Project Management, Software Engineering, Quantity Surveying or any related discipline together with evidence of a minimum 10 years of verifiable practice experience;
- k. In the case of Consortium/Joint Venture:
 - The individual firms making the consortium must fulfil the prequalification requirement above
 - A copy of the Memorandum of Understanding
- Verifiable documentary evidence of at least three (3) similar jobs (in size, nature & complexity) executed in the last five (5) years including Letters of Awards, Valuation Certificates, Job Completion Certificates and Photographs of the projects. Note: the Board will conduct physical verification of similar jobs;
- m. For Lot A1 and A3 Evidence of Firm's current registration/accreditation with Computer Professionals Registration Council of Nigeria (CPN) and National Information Technology

Development Agency (NITDA). Note: Firm's specialisation in Project Management, Software Engineering or any other related discipline together with minimum of 5 years of verifiable practice experience of the Principals of the firm;

- n. For Lots A5 to A11 Evidence of 2024 Annual Renewal with Environmental Health Officers Registration Council of Nigeria;
- o. For Lot B1: the following requirements must be met;
 - I. Evidence of Contact Centre Value Added Service (VAS) license from the Nigeria Communication Commission (NCC) for;
 - II. Evidence of Short Code Value Added Service (VAS) license from the Nigeria Communication Commission (NCC);
 - III. Evidence of partnership with at least 2 Telecommunication operators e.g. Interconnect clearing houses or Mobile Network Operators;
 - IV. Evidence of the firm's compliance with the Nigeria Data Protection Regulatory (NDPR)
- p. All documents for submission must be transmitted with a Covering/Forwarding letter under the Company/Firm's Letter Head Paper bearing amongst others, the Registration Number (RC) as issued by the Corporate Affairs Commission (CAC), Contact Address, Telephone Number (preferably GSM Number), and e-mail address. The Letterhead Paper must bear the Names and Nationalities of the Directors of the Company at the bottom of the page, duly signed by the authorised officer of the firm.

3.0 COLLECTION OF TENDER DOCUMENTS (GOODS)

5.0 **GENERAL INFORMATION**

- a. Bids and Expression of Interest (EoI) must be in English Language and signed by an officer authorised by the Bidder;
- b. Bids and Expression of Interest (EoI) submitted after the deadline for submission would be returned un-opened;
- c. Bidders should not bid for more than two (2) Lots;
- d. For Category A: Only shortlisted firms will be invited at a later date for collection of Request for Proposal;
- e. All costs will be borne by the bidders;
- f. Non-compliance with the conditions stated herein will lead to automatic disqualification of the bidder from the biding process;

- g. Technical and Financial Bids enclosed in one and same single envelope that will expose the Technical and Financial Bids at the same time of opening shall be disqualified;
- h. For Category B: only prequalified bidders at technical evaluation will be invited at a later date for financial bid opening, while the financial bid of unsuccessful bidders will be returned unopened;
